Rigging Area



Are arriving by water (see plan at the end of this doc) - we will get there!


ELECTRICAL POWER LINES - AVOID!!!

- Do not sail or hover above the start area

Plan for RPAYC competitors

Generally; in and out of PBSC by water both days

<u>Applies to</u>; Chris, (Daniel – TBC), Gary, Louis, Will, Steph, Marcus and Jervis... (Belle is doing Sunday only and working to a different plan)

Saturday

RPA WASZPs, RIBs, marks and people need to be at PBSC about 11.30 for a 12 briefing.

Proposal is to rig and sail (if wind) or tow with RIBs (if not). Either way, need to allow an hour. So, arrive and rig at 10 to leave at 10.30.

Non-sailing gear needs to go on RIBs (together with a number of marks) including:

- Dolly
- Covers; pack up small and tight with a label
- Personal kit; clothes, food, etc.

Boats will stay at PBSC (it's a beach!) overnight and we will RIB back to RPA.

Sunday

RIB to PBSC for 12 briefing; meet at 11.15 with personal / sailing kit.

After racing; the SIs have the skinniest possible protest time so the request is that we all go ashore and wing down in the water / sand for the presso.

We need to get dollies and covers etc. back on the RIBs.

After presso, we will have a (informal) Le Mans style race from the beach to the Pole at the RMYC.
