1. ARRIVAL

The boat park is next to the beach in front of the hanger. Vehicles may enter the site to unload boats but must be removed and parked in the parking outside the main gate as soon as the boat is unloaded.

The camping field is item 2 on the map. If possible, please check in at reception (Accueil) before entering the camping area. Reception is open 0830-1730. Pre-booked camping pitches should have signs with names on if you cannot access reception.



2. COMMUNICATIONS

3. MEASUREMENT



Boats must measure before registration.

Boats may be measured any time from 14 July until registration closes at 1800 on Monday 17 July.

Sailors are encouraged to measure early to avoid the last-minute rush.

The measurement team will consist of:

- Martin Evans: WASZP Class Manager
- Jervis Tilly: Australian WASZP Class President
- Frédérique Pfeiffer: FFVoile Measurer

There is no specific time slot to measure. The measurement team will be in the boat park and available to measure boats throughout the day. They will be wearing black t-shirts with the WASZP shield front and back. The team will work around you so that you can focus on going sailing and preparing for the championship.

If you are ready to measure, ask one of the measurers directly or message/call +447792177590 on WhatsApp.

The procedure

All boats must be prepared to measure as follows:

- Wings down and control systems in place
- Rig down and sail ready to unroll
- Foils bolted together
- Foil covers off
- HELMET!

The measurers will give you a slip to complete.

If you pass, the slip will be signed. If you fail, the measurer will note the issues to rectify and will remeasure you when you are ready.

Take your signed slip to registration in the Formation Building to collect your event shirt and Rooster bow sticker.

4. REGISTRATION



Boats must measure before registration.

Registration will be open in the Formation Building at the following times:

- Sunday 16 July: 1330 - 1800
- Monday 17 July: 0900-1200 and 1330-1800

Take your signed measurement ticket to registration.

You will be asked to confirm your details and may be asked for confirmation of the entry requirements listed in the NOR (please check before registration).

When everything is confirmed, you will receive an event t-shirt and Rooster bow sticker.

The Green Fleet coach is Ross Harvey - a very experienced foiling coach that many people will know from the SailGP Inspire program.
