### 3. MEASUREMENT

Boats must measure before registration.

Boats competing in the Australian nationals must measure between 0900 and 1600 on 6 December or 0900 and 1100 on 7 December.

Boats entered only for the Games may be measured any time from 0800 to 1800 on 10 December.

You can only measure once, so before measuring, ensure you have selected the gear you will be using for the Games. If measuring before the Australian Nationals, you may measure in your Games gear and use different gear for the nationals. Your plan must be made clear to the measurers as you start to interact with them.

The measurement team will consist of:

Phil Troop: Head of Technical Committee

Jervis Tilly: Australian WASZP Class President

Andrew McDougall: Designer

There is no specific time slot to measure. The measurement team will be in the boat park (probably in red shirts) and available to measure boats throughout the day. The team will work around you so that you can focus on going sailing and preparing for the championship.

Sailors are encouraged to measure early to avoid any last-minute rush.

If you are ready to measure, ask one of the measurers directly or message/call the contacts above.



### The measurement procedure

All boats must be prepared to measure as follows:

Wings down and control systems in place

Rig down and sail ready to unroll

Foils glued and bolted together

Foil covers off

HELMET available

<u>Please be prepared for the measurers to make the process as efficient as possible.</u>

The measurers will give you a slip to complete. Those sailing the nationals will have their slip kept on file for Games registration.

If you pass, the slip will be signed. If you fail, the measurer will note the issues to rectify and a measurer will remeasure you when you are ready.

Take your signed slip to registration to complete registration. For the Games this will include collecting your event shirt.



Some notes to prepare before arriving at the event:

Ensure your boat complies with the class rules.

With all aspects of rules compliance (including the points below), don't take chances as you could find yourself in a last-minute rush; solve all issues early!

### Sail Numbers and National Identifiers:

National letters or a national flag on the sail are a requirement for the Games.

A strict policy will be in place for the correct size and font for numbers and national letters. This is crucial to successful lap counting and recording of results in big fleets. Make sure you can be spotted among the other 80 boats.

### Foil Tips

Fairing/altering foil tips is strictly prohibited in the WASZP class. The class rules specify an allowance to smooth damage within 5mm of the leading and trailing edges. Any work elsewhere on the tips that means the surface is not 'as manufactured' could result in failing measurement. If in doubt, change the tips early or contact <a href="mailto:class@waszp.com">class@waszp.com</a> for advice.

Tip: if you have scratches on the tips, use a sharp Stanley knife blade laid along the surface to take off any raised parts.

#### <u>Helmets</u>

Helmets are mandatory for all competitors at both events and will be inspected at measurement. Ensure your helmet is of the standard CE EN 1385 or equivalent.



### 4. REGISTRATION

Boats must measure **before** registration.

Registration will be open in the club at the following times:

Wednesday 6 December: 1200-1600 (Nationals)

Thursday 7 December: 0900-1100 (Nationals)

Sunday 10 December: 0900-1800 (Games)

Take your signed measurement ticket to registration.

You will be asked to confirm your details. Please check you are sailing under the correct sail number, age division and rig size on your entry list!

To aid boat spotting, at Registration we will be collecting / confirming Hull colour, Tramp colour and Sail colour – there will be further communication on this.

When your registration is complete, you will receive an event shirt.



### 5. GREEN FLEET

Green Fleet is a coached fleet during the Games aimed at beginners who need a helping hand getting around the course.

The program is totally flexible and you can choose to join or leave before sailing on any day during the Games. Green Fleet will have a dedicated coach to shadow sailors around the course, offer daily briefings and debriefs and the capacity to set up a separate smaller course for those that don't feel comfortable in the main fleet.

There is a specific WhatsApp group for the Green Fleet so the coach can communicate efficiently with sailors - link or scan below.
