NOTICE OF RACE V3

8-11th April 2021



The Organising Authority is Sorrento Sailing Couta Boat Club in conjunction with the Australian WASZP Association

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including AS Special Regulations Pt 2
- 1.2. Appendices S: Standard Sailing Instructions and T: Arbitration will apply as modified.
- 1.3. RRS S3 is replaced with. Amendments to the SI made ashore will be posted at least 30 mins before the start of any race affected. Amendments made afloat will be signaled by the display of flag L with 5 sound signals. The Race Committee may communicate these either verbally or in writing.
- 1.4. When the AP flag is displayed ashore, 60 mins is replaced with 20 mins. This changes RRS S4.2.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Eligible classes - WASZP
- 2.2. The Official Notice Board <https://sscbc.com.au/waszps21/> has links to the entry form, other conditions and an alert about the risks of sailing, which the person entering the boat must agree to.

3. FEES

- 3.1. The fee is \$180 and includes after race feed (light meal)
- 3.2. Late entries or late payments after Wed 31 March welcomed with additional \$50 fee.

4. FORMAT

- 4.1. Racing will be run in sessions, optimised daily to the weather forecast so that 5 formats of racing and competition are run over the games:
 - Australian Championship series of 9 races with Grand Prix Scoring
 - ~~Downwind Slalom Course Series (Round Robin / Elimination style scoring)~~
 - Speed Demons – Best GPS measured Max Speed and Sustained Speed each day

5. SCHEDULE – (Early drop off available – Early Registration Wednesday 7 April – 5.00-6.30 pm)

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1. The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions and supplementary sailing instructions (SSI) that will be on the Official Notice Board. SSIs provided at registration.

7. SIGN ON – SIGN OFF

- 7.1. Boats will be sent a link to the mobile number they register with to sign on before going afloat and sign off at the first reasonable opportunity upon returning ashore. Sign on and off can also be done at the Regatta Office. [DP]

8. VENUE, REGATTA OFFICE, FLAG-POLE

- 8.1. Sorrento Sailing Couta Boat Club, 3154 Point Nepean Rd, Sorrento VIC 3943
- 8.2. The Regatta Office is the Sailing Centre at the North-East Corner of the Clubhouse and the Flagpole is to the North-East of it.

9. THE COURSES

- 9.1. WASZP Grand Prix and Slalom courses off the Club.

10. SCORING

- 10.1. Each format will be scored separately.
- 10.2. Three races are required to constitute a series.
- 10.3. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score once 3 races are completed and excluding her worst 2 scores once 6 races have been completed.

11. PRIZES

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded for each event format.

12. INSURANCE

- 12.1. Boats shall maintain \$5m third-party public liability insurance cover at all times.
