



NOTICE OF RACE
for
WASZP State Championships
and
Moth State Championships



19, 20 & 21 November 2021

The Organising Authority is Mounts Bay Sailing Club

[NP] – denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for protest by a boat

[DP] – denotes a rule of which the penalty is at discretion of the protest committee and may be less than disqualification.

1. RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* except as any of these is altered by this Notice of Race or by the Sailing Instructions and/or the WASZP and Moth Class rules.
- 1.2** The Australian Sailing Prescriptions shall apply to all entries.
- 1.3** [DP] The Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 Off the Beach, will apply.
- 1.4** Racing rule 44.1 will be changed as follows: The two-turns penalty in rule 44.1 is replaced by a part-turn. It is a gybe and coming to close-hauled on a windward leg or a tack and sailing below 90 degrees on any other leg.
- 1.5** Appendix T will apply.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1** [DP] Boats may be required to display advertising as chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the WASZP and Moth Class
- 3.2** Eligible boats may enter online on the Event Webpage by completing the entry form and making the online payment of \$130. Entries close Friday, 12 November 2021 at 5:00pm.
- 3.3** Late entries will be accepted with a late fee of an additional \$50.
- 3.4** To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a Club recognised by the competitor's National Authority. Proof of affiliated Club membership to be submitted with entry.
- 3.5** All helms less than 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations.

4. SCHEDULE

5. MEASUREMENT

5.1 All boats shall comply with RRS 78.1

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available prior to the event.

7. VENUE & COURSE AREAS

7.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue and course areas.

8. COURSES

8.1 Friday, Saturday and Sunday - Windward/leeward courses

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 RRS 44.1 is changed as described in NOR 1.4.

9.2 The Post-Race Penalty in RRS T1(B) is changed to 25% of the difference.

10. SCORING

10.1 A minimum of three races shall be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 The scoring system will be described in full in the sailing instructions.

10.3 For each Class, the protest time limit and redress time limit is 45 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day “or two hours after the incident, whichever is later” is deleted from RRS 62.2.

11. SUPPORT BOATS

11.1 Support boats are allowed and shall be registered with the OA and shall have a working VHF radio for communications with Race Committee and shall act as rescue boats if required to do so. [DP]

12. PRIZES

12.1 WASZP State Championship

- 6.9 Rig - 1st, 2nd, 3rd Overall
- 8.2 Rig – 1st, 2nd, 3rd Overall

12.2 Moth State Championships

- 1st, 2nd, 3rd Overall

12.3 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.

13. INSURANCE

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD\$10,000,000 per incident or the equivalent in currency.

13.2 Proof of Insurance shall be provided on registration.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 RRS, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14.2 The Organising Authority, host club or their staff and volunteers will not accept any liability for any damage or loss caused to boats berthed at the event.

15. SOCIAL

15.1 A presentation gathering will be held at the Dinghy/Junior Clubhouse promptly after racing on, 21 November 2021.
