



Ullswater Daffodil Regatta

Notice of Race

23rd to 24th April 2022



1. OVERARCHING

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the rules as defined in 'The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 - 2024 (RRS), the Prescriptions of the RYA, the relevant Class Rules, this NOR and the Sailing Instructions in ascending order.
- 1.2 The organising authority will be UYC Ltd in conjunction with the relevant Class Association(s) and / or Governing Body (ies).
- 1.3 Competitors should note that UYC Ltd operate the RYA Racing Charter and they will be expected to sail in compliance with the Charter.
- 1.4 The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to any monohull dinghy/dayboat/cruiser; any boat entered must be under 25'6". A boat without a recognised/representative Portsmouth Yardstick will be assigned one based on other available data, this yardstick may be reviewed at any time after race 1.
- 3.2 Class measurement certificates may be required to be produced.
- 3.3 All entries must be made on line at
The Sailing Committee reserves the right to refuse entries.
- 3.4 Competitors, including support teams, coaches, instructors, rescue crews and immediate and families etc., shall consider themselves visitors/temporary members of UYC for the duration of the event. Visitors not directly connected with a boat entered into the event will be required to pay a temporary visitor fee.
- 3.5 Visiting boats out with the classes as mentioned in fleet 1 in paragraph 6 Fleet 2 will be sailing a club course this entry will be limited to 30 boats.

4. FEES

- 4.1 Entry fees for visitors will be £45.00 for double hander and £35.00 for single hander.
- 4.3 Online entry closes Wednesday 20th April at midnight. Entries will be taken at the Saturday reception and will be subject to a £10.00 late entry fee.
- 4.4 Club members in Fleet 2 Entry is free.

5. OTHER FEES

5.1 Fees for visitor camping for the Daffodil Regatta are shown below;

6. SCHEDULE

6.1 All competitors must attend Saturday registration between 09:00 to 10:30

6.2 Competitors briefing will be held at the Race Office on Event Saturday at 11:00

6.4 The organisers may combine, divide or add classes depending on the number of entries

6.5 The warning signal for the last race on 24th of April will be no later than 3pm

6.6 There will be a maximum of four starts per fleet

6.7 The duration of each race will be approximately 30 to 45 minutes

6.8 The number of races completed to constitute a series will be 2

6.9 A boat's series score where more than 2 races are completed is shown in the table below

6.10 Scoring will be the low points scoring system of Appendix 'A'

7. SAILINGINSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration and on the UYC website

8. VENUE

- 8.1 UYC is situated on the north east shore of the lake approximately two miles from Pooley Bridge on the Howtown Road.
- 8.2 There will be separate racing areas for Fleet 1 and Fleet 2.

9. COURSES

- 9.1. Fleet 1 will sail a Windward/ Leeward course
- 9.2. Fleet 2 will sail more conventional courses that will include club buoys.
- 9.3 Courses are displayed at the bottom of the notice and race. But we are not limited to using them courses. If there is a change to the courses which are displayed below this will be explained at the briefing on Saturday.

10. PRIZES AND TROPHIES

- 10.1 Prizes and trophies will be awarded in proportion to the number of entries in each Class.
- 10.2 The prize giving will be held at the UYC Clubhouse on the final day, approximately one hour after the last boat finishes, subject to protests.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

- 12.1 All competitors shall warrant that they are covered by adequate third-party insurance cover of £3m.
