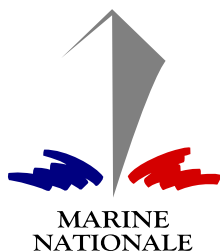

The Grand Prix de l'Ecole Navale - Championnat de France de Voile Monotypes Habitables (GPEN-CFMH) is an official event of the Fédération Française de Voile organized by the « Association de soutien au Grand Prix de l'Ecole Navale (AGPEN) », from 08 to 11 May 2024 in the following locations: Ecole Navale, Crozon Morgat, Camaret, Roscanvel and Brest.

Preamble

Prevention of violence and incivility

Sporting events are above all a space for exchange and sharing, open and accessible to all.

As such, competitors and support persons are asked to behave in all circumstances, ashore and afloat, in a courteous and respectful manner, regardless of the origin, gender or sexual orientation of other participants.

The notation [NP] in a rule means that a boat cannot protest (No protest) against another boat when infringing this rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

The notation [DP] in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. RULES

The event is governed by:

- 1.1 the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*,
- 1.2 national prescriptions, translated in English for non-French-speaking competitors, in joined appendix 1 "Prescriptions".
- 1.3 FFVoile regulations, including the regulation of the « Championnat de France Monotypes Habitables. » <https://umbraco.ffvoile.fr/media/tkzdo4sh/r/%C3%A8glement-du-cfmh-2024.pdf>
- 1.4 From sunset to sunrise, the rules of part 2 of the RRS are replaced by part B, section II of the IRPCAS (International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea)
- 1.5 In case of translation of this NoR, the French text shall prevail.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (Sis)

The Sis will be published on the website « www.agpen.fr » no later than the 06th of May 2024.

3. COMMUNICATION:

- 3.1 The online notice board can be found at following web address www.agpen.fr
- 3.2 [DP] [NP] From the first warning signal, until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The Grand Prix de l'Ecole Navale is open to boats of following classes: Corsaire, Muscadet, Diam 24OD, J80, J70, Seascope 24, Open 5.70, Flying Fifteen, Valid and Invalid (Mini J), Open 500, Figaro Beneteau 3, Birdyfish and Waszp.

Classes competing for a « Championnat de France Monotypes Habitables » are defined in NoR 11.2.

The FFVoile has the right to award a title of « Champion de France » to any affiliated one design class answering the regulation of the "Championnat de France Monotypes Habitables".

The FFVoile, in agreement with the OA, has the right to invite any other one design class wishing to take part in this event.

If less than 8 boats from a class are not regularly registered by the 17th of April 2024, such class will not be admitted to participate. In doing so, the OA will contact this class and will communicate the decision.

No registration will be accepted after the 3rd of May 2024.

- 4.2 Each crew member shall wear at all time while afloat a personal flotation device. Each boat shall have onboard at the minimum the safety equipment required by class rules and current regulation. When registering, each skipper shall certify the compliance of the mandatory equipment onboard (see NoR 4.7). Except for MiniJ, Birdyfish and Waszp, each boat shall be equipped with a VHF in working order.

4.3 Number of crew members

(i) During registration of boats from one design classes mentioned in 4.1, the skipper or boat captain will confirm the crew list and the number of crew members on board, skipper or boat captain included. Except for MiniJ and Waszp (singlehanded), the number of crew members shall answer the class rules and the minimum of 2 crew members.

The crews of Figaro Beneteau 3 shall be constituted with 4 crew members, one of which being a woman and two of which being members aged from 16 to 26. The date of the age reference is the competitor age on December 31st 2024. For 2024, this corresponds with competitors born between January 1st 1998 and December 31st 2008 included.

(ii) For all classes, during whole event (from first to last race sailed), the number of crew members onboard, including skipper or boat captain, shall not be modified, except after hearing and jury decision, further to a request justified by exceptional circumstances.

4.4 Crews shall register online from 1st March 2024 on the website of the “Grand Prix de l’Ecole Navale” at following address www.agpen.fr/inscriptions/

The registration file will be available through the creation of a customer account. If needed, it will be possible to complete it subsequently. The whole entry fees have to be paid online by credit card as described in NoR 5(ii). After validation of the file by the organizer, the registrant will receive a registration confirmation e-mail as well as the badges of the registered people.

All documents required for the boat and the crew, mentioned in NoR 4.5 and 4.6 shall be uploaded on the registration file.

Specific case: Crews taking part in the «National sailing championship for the Federation of Clubs of the Defense department (FCD) » shall register with the FCD by the 17th of April 2024, and not on AGPEN website.

The FCD will manage registration on GPEN website for all FCD crews.

Crews selected by UNSS (National Union for Student Sport) management shall register online on GPEN website. Please contact the AGPEN for practicalities (inscriptions@agpen.fr).

4.5 Required documents for competitor’s registration

a) For each competitor having a FFVoile Club licence:

- the valid FFVoile club licence with “Competition” mention
- or
- the valid FFVoile club licence with “Adhesion” or “Pratique” mention, accompanied with
 - for minors, a testimonial of completion of a questionnaire related to the health condition of the minor competitor

 - for adults, a medical certificate dated less than one year, mentioning the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition

b) For each competitor without a FFVoile Club licence, whether foreign or French national living abroad shall present during registration:

- a supporting document to justify membership to a World Sailing Member national authority.
- a supporting document to justify a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 2 million Euros.
- for minors, a testimonial of completion of a questionnaire related to the health condition of the minor competitor or, for adults, a medical certificate dated less than one year, mentioning the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition

c) a parental authorization for any minor competitor (downloadable file on AGPEN website www.agpen.fr/inscriptions/).

4.6 Required documents for boat registration

- the measurement form or rating certificate of the boat, when its presentation is required by a class rule
- if necessary a valid authorization to display advertising on the boat.

4.7 When registering online, each skipper shall read and validate the following commitments by ticking a box:

- « *The skipper agrees, on his behalf and on behalf of his crew, to abide by the Racing Rules of Sailing and any other rules governing this event* ».

- « *The skipper certifies the compliance of the compulsory equipment onboard of his boat* ».

4.8 **Support persons**
All support persons shall register online on GPEN 2024 website and pay the fees mentioned in 5(i).

4.9 **Safety requirement governing access to the Ecole Navale:**
Following provisions particularly important for the crews and support persons of J80, J70, Seascope 24, Waszp and Birdyfish, located in Ecole Navale.

For the crews and support persons assigned to other racing areas, they grant right of access to the prize giving and competitors dinner on Saturday evening.

The access to the Ecole Navale is subject to authorization granted by the military authorities. When registering online to the event, the crew list has to be detailed, including potential substitutes or support persons (name, forename, date of birth, place and department of birth, nationality). **This provision also applies to drivers convoying boats assigned to the Ecole Navale area (J80, J70, Seascope 24, Birdyfish and Waszp) needing access to the venue.**

The whole information shall be completed through entry file, available on AGPEN website www.agpen.fr/inscriptions

Due to processing time of access requests, **required information shall be given asap to OA, and in any case, before 15/04/2024 for foreign persons and 30/04/2024 for French citizens.**

OA will not be liable in case of access to the venue declined by the military authorities. Impossibility of access to the Ecole Navale venue will not be grant for request for redress (this changes RRS 62.1).

5. ENTRY FEES :

Note: MiniJ class will cover 30€ for each MiniJ registration. MiniJ competitors shall consequently pay only 60€ on registration website (100€ from 23 April).

(ii) **Payment methods:**

Registration being possible only online, payments shall be made online by **credit card**. However, crews without credit card shall indicate it by emailing to inscriptions@agpen.fr in order to settle the transaction.

Exceptionally and after previous agreement received by mail, this payment will be settled by bank transfer to:

IMPORTANT: Mention class, name and sail number of the boat in the transfer wording.

Entries will be refunded if the event is cancelled because of a French government decision.

Except in the case of force majeure, left to OA discretion, no refunding will be granted in case of cancellation of a boat, after April 17th 2024.

If a competitor or support person registered in the event cannot go to the venue of the event, because of health or safety reasons implemented by his region or country, hence reducing mobility towards the event venue, no refund request regarding travel and accommodation expenses paid by the participants will be accepted.

When entering the event, each participant acknowledges to be aware of such state of affairs.

6. ADVERTISING:

[DP] [NP] Boats shall display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

7. SCHEDULE :

The schedule for each venue is provided in Appendix 4.

Classes are allocated to venues and race areas as follows:

- Areas A, B - at Ecole Navale port facilities for J80, J70, Seascope 24, Birdyfish and Waszp
- Area C - in Brest (Harbour Moulin Blanc – room Cormorandière) for Mini J
- Area D - in Camaret at harbour master for Figaro Beneteau 3, Corsaire, Muscadet and Diam 24 OD
- Area E - in Crozon Morgat (nautical centre) for Open 570 and Flying Fifteen
- Area F - in Roscanvel at the Fort of Roscanvel for Open 500.

8. MEASUREMENT AND LAUNCHING OF THE BOATS :

8.1 No sail certification de voile will be organized during entry confirmation

If required by class rules, crews may be weighed by draw.

8.2 Fleets will be allocated to the areas in accordance with Nor 7. The OA may change such allocation, with an amendment.

For each boat finally entered, the OA will cover the expenses corresponding with docking taxes in the harbours of Crozon Morgat, Camaret, Roscanvel and Brest Port du Moulin Blanc for the period of the competition.

The OA will also cover one launching before the event and one hauling out after the event.

For craning on Saturday 11th May and Sunday 12th May, crews shall follow the craning order given by the OA and posted on the official notice board on each venue.

8.3 Boats will be craned with their own hoisting straps or lanyards, answering the craning standards. **Mast lift and dismasting will be managed by the crews.**

9. COURSES

Race areas are defined in appendix 3.

Courses will be « up and down » courses, « Speed Crossing » and coastal courses.

Other courses may be set up.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 For all eligible classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the two-turns penalty is replaced by the one-turn penalty.

10.2 Judging afloat may be implemented. Conditions will be detailed in the SIs.

11. RANKING AND TITLES

11.1. 3 races are required to be completed to complete the event.

11.2. « Champion de France » titles will be awarded to the first crews of the J80 and Open 5.70 classes, in accordance with the regulation of the Championnat de France Monotypes Habitables 2024 available at following address <https://umbraco.ffvoile.fr/media/tkzdo4sh/r%C3%A8glement-du-cfmh-2024.pdf>

For Diam 24 OD, Corsaire, Mini J and Muscadet classes, a « Champion de France » title will be awarded if at least 15 boats compete in the event. « Champion de France » titles may be awarded to foreign crews. The remaining eligible classes will compete for the Grand Prix de l'École Navale :

- Flying Fifteen for the European Championship
- WASZP for the Euro Cup.

11.3 The 3 top crews of each eligible class will be rewarded.

- 11.4 National Sailing Championship of the « Fédération des clubs de la Défense » :
The trophy of this National sailing championship will be awarded to the first J80 with the whole crew having justified his belonging to a Défense club during entry confirmation. Crews wishing to participate in this championship shall register with FCD.
The result will be an extract of the general ranking, without points recalculating.
- 11.5 UNSS J80 Masters (National Union for Student Sport)
Six **UNSS** crews will be selected by UNSS management in order to participate in the UNSS J80 Masters. The ranking of this event will be obtained with an extract of the general ranking, without points recalculating.
- 12. BERTHING**
[NP] [DP] Boats shall remain in their place allocated by the OA upon arrival.
- 13. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**
- 13.1 [DP] [NP] Except for Waszp, Birdyfish, Diam 24OD during the whole competition, boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta, except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.
- 13.2 Except for Diam 24OD, Waszp and Birdyfish, if so decided by the harbour authorities, the OA of the event may ask the competitors to be ready to sail to another harbour of the bay. Adapted crew for handling the boat shall be permanently onboard. As soon as requested, relevant boats shall immediately sail to the designated harbour. In case of infringement, the boat may, after hearing, be ranked DNE by the jury, without pre-empting any legal action taken by the AO.
- 14 DATA PROTECTION**
- 14.1 **Image and appearance rights** : Participating in the competition, the competitor and his legal representative authorize the OA, the FFVoile and their sponsors to use free of charge his image and his name, to show at any time (during and after the competition) static or moving pictures, films or TV recording, as well as other reproduction from himself done during the competition, and this on any support and for any use related to the promotion of their activities.
- 14.2 **Use of personal data of participants**: Participating in this competition, the competitor and his legal representatives agree to and authorize the FFVoile, its sponsors, as well as the OA to use and store, free of charge, his personal data. These data may be published by FFVoile and its sponsors. The FFVoile mainly, but also its sponsors may use these data for the development of software's or for marketing purposes. In accordance with the « Règlement Général sur la Protection des Données (RGPD) » (General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)), any competitor having transmitted his personal data to the FFVoile, may exercise his right to access to his own data, have them modified, and, depending on the situations, have them deleted, limited, or to object them, sending an email to dpo@ffvoile.fr or a letter to the Head Office of the Fédération Française de Voile, mentioning that the request is related to personal data.
- 15. RECOGNITION OF RISKS**
RRS 3 mentions: « The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone. » Participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges the fact that sailing is potentially a dangerous activity with specific risks. These risks include strong winds and rough sea, sudden changes of weather conditions, failure of equipment, mistakes in boat handling, bad navigation of other boats, loss of balance on unstable surface, thus causing increased risk of injury. The risk of material and/or physical damage is therefore inherent in the sport of sailing.
- 16. INFORMATION :**
- 16.1. **Competitors accommodation is not supported by the OA, except for the competitors entered in the « Championnat national de voile de la fédération des clubs de la Défense » and in the « UNSS J80 Masters », who will be accommodated in the Ecole navale.**

16.2 **Accommodation information :**
The Ascension week-end is very popular in the area and accommodation will be restricted. It is highly recommended to the competitors to book their accommodation as soon as they have registered.

16.4 **Environment:**

The Grand Prix de l'Ecole Navale - Championnat de France Monotypes Habitables is involved in an environmental approach. This sports event takes place in preserved sites (Natura 2000). Each competitor will respect the environment, will separate garbage collection and will not put waste into the sea. Garbage bags and garbage collection bags will be distributed during welcome.

16.5 **Prohibition of drones:**

Competitors are informed by the OA on the fact that because of the pointe Finistère hosting several sensitive military facilities, any non-military aircraft fly-over is forbidden in Brest bay, Douarnenez bay as well as Iroise sea. Such interdiction also applies to drone flights. Professional flights may exceptionally be authorised by Brest Maritime Prefecture.

Appendix 1

Prescriptions of the Fédération Française de Voile Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024

FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 25** (*Notice of race, sailing instructions and signals*):

For events graded 4 and 5, standard notices of race and sailing instructions including the specificities of the event shall be used. Events graded 4 may have dispensation for such requirement, after receipt of FFVoile approval, received before the notice of race has been published.

For events graded 5, posting of sailing instructions will be considered as meeting the requirements of RRS 25.1 application.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 64.4** (*Decisions on protests concerning class rules*):

The jury may ask the parties to the protest, prior to checking procedures, a deposit covering the cost of checking arising from a protest concerning class rules.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 67** (*Damages*):

Any question or request related to damages arising from an incident occurred while a boat was bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing depends on the appropriate courts and cannot be examined and dealt by a jury.

A boat that retires from a race or accepts a penalty does not, by that such action, admit liability for damages.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 70.5** (*Appeals and requests to a national authority*):

The denial of the right of appeal is subject to the written authorization of the Fédération Française de Voile, received before publishing the notice of race. This authorization shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 76** (*Exclusion of boats or competitors*):

An organizing authority or race committee shall not reject or cancel the entry of a boat or exclude a competitor eligible under the notice of race and sailing instructions for an arbitrary reason.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 78.1** (*Compliance with class rules; certificates*):

The boat's owner or other person in charge shall, under his sole responsibility, make sure moreover that his boat complies with the equipment and security rules required by the laws, by-laws and regulations of the Administration.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 86.3** (*Changes to the racing rules*):

An organizing authority wishing to change a rule listed in RRS 86.1(a) in order to develop or test new rules shall first submit the changes to the FFVoile, in order to obtain its written approval and shall report the results to FFVoile after the event. Such authorization shall be mentioned in the notice of race and in the sailing instructions and shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 88** (*National prescriptions*):

Prescriptions of the FFVoile shall neither be changed nor deleted in the notice of race and sailing instructions, except for events for which an international jury has been appointed.

In such case, the prescriptions marked with an asterisk (*) shall neither be changed nor deleted in the notice of race and sailing instructions. (The official translation of the prescriptions, downloadable on the FFVoile website (<https://arbitrage.ffvoile.fr/media/cehepshz/prescriptions-rrs-2021-2024-version-gbr-2.doc>), shall be the only translation used to comply with RRS 90.2(b)).

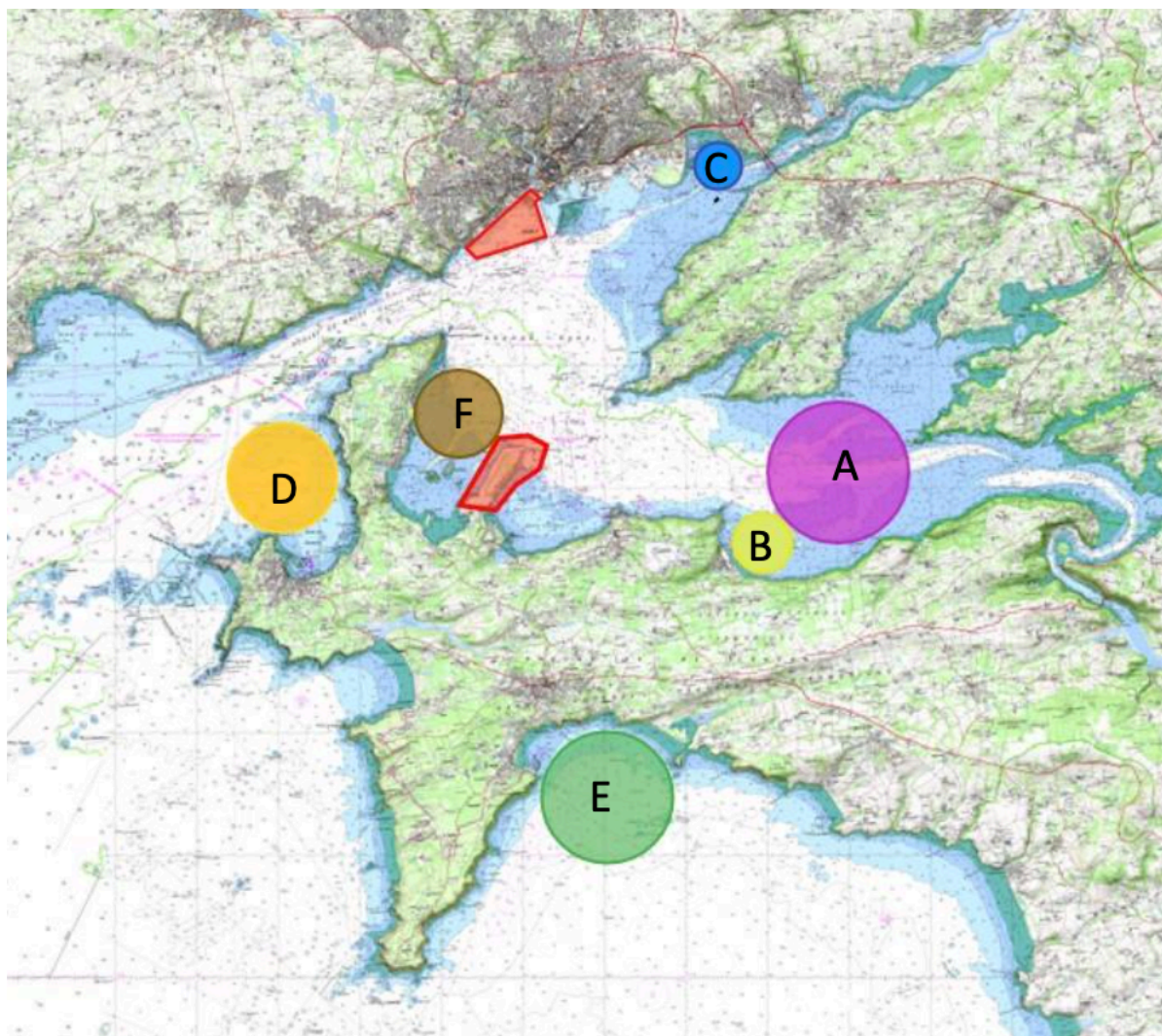
