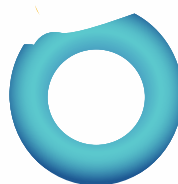

The notation '[NP]' in a rule of the sailing instructions (SIs) means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the Rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Appendix P (Special procedures for Rule 42) will apply, as amended in NOR section 14.
- 1.3 Appendix T (Arbitration) will apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available at <https://racehub.waszp.com/eventdetail/317> prior to the first day of the event.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the WASZP class.
- 4.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online at <https://racehub.waszp.com/eventdetail/317>.
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.4 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Before 11 August, the entry fee for the event is €130.
- 5.2 After 11 August, the entry fee for the event is €180.
- 5.3 Entry closes on 13 October 2024.
- 5.4 For cancellations after 13 October 2024, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded. For cancellations after 25 October 2024, 10% of the entry fee will be refunded.

6 CREW LIMITATIONS

In accordance with the class rules.

7 ADVERTISING [NP] [DP]

- 7.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

8 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

Not applicable to this event.

9 SCHEDULE

- 9.1 The table below outlines the event schedule:

1 November	Slalom mini-series and Island Race	Post-sail drinks

- 9.2 A maximum of 5 Championship races may be sailed on one day. Any number of slalom or alternative style races may be raced on one day.
- 9.3 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1500.

10 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 10.1 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the *rules*.
- 10.2 The penalty for infringements of class rules may be less than disqualification.

11 CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

- 11.1 Wet clothing may be inspected at any time for compliance with the *rules*.

12 VENUE

- 12.1 The event will be held at Opg Matulic, Pašman 2, 23262, Pašman, Croatia
- 12.2 The racing area will be in any of the areas surrounding the island of Babac.

13 COURSES

- 13.1 The courses will be described in the sailing instructions. Championship courses will consist of windward/leeward courses; Slalom courses will be a downwind course with reaching start; and the Island course will be a course that uses local islands as

rounding marks.

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 14.1 RRS 44.1 and P2.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 14.2 RRS P2.2 and P2.3 will not apply. RRS P2.1 applies to all penalties under Appendix P. RRS P5 does not apply.

15 SCORING

- 15.1 The final rank of the Slalom mini-series will count as one race towards the overall series.
- 15.2 The Island Race will count as one race towards the overall series.
- 15.3 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 15.4 The championship series will be scored as follows:
 - a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores.
 - b) When from 4 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - c) When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

16 SUPPORT VESSELS

- 16.1 Support vessels may be permitted at the event subject to the approval of the organising authority.
- 16.2 [DP] Private support vessels shall make themselves available to all sailors for safety or towing duties as requested by the race committee.
- 16.3 [DP] Support vessels shall stay at least 150m from the course area and shall be at least 150m towards the pre-start side of the starting line and its extensions after the warning signal until the starting signal.
- 16.4 Further rules regarding support vessels may be found in the sailing instructions.

17 CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS

Not applicable to this event.

18 BERTHING

- 18.1 [DP] [NP] Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the boat park.

19 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Not applicable to this event.

20 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Not applicable to this event.

21 DATA PROTECTION

- 21.1 The personal information you provide to the Organising Authority will be used to facilitate your participation in the event and will be stored and used in accordance with the Organising Authority's privacy policy. To facilitate your participation in the event, or when required by the rules, personal information may be shared with event officials, your national governing body, and/or World Sailing. Relevant media, results and the outcome of any hearing or appeal may be published.

22 RISK STATEMENT

- 22.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

23 INSURANCE

- 23.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1.5 million per incident or the equivalent.

24 PRIZES

- 24.1 Prize categories will be outlined in the sailing instructions, but will include the top three men, top three women, top 6.9 and the winner of each age category.
- 24.2 Prizes for the overall EuroCup series may be presented.
