1. LOCATIONS

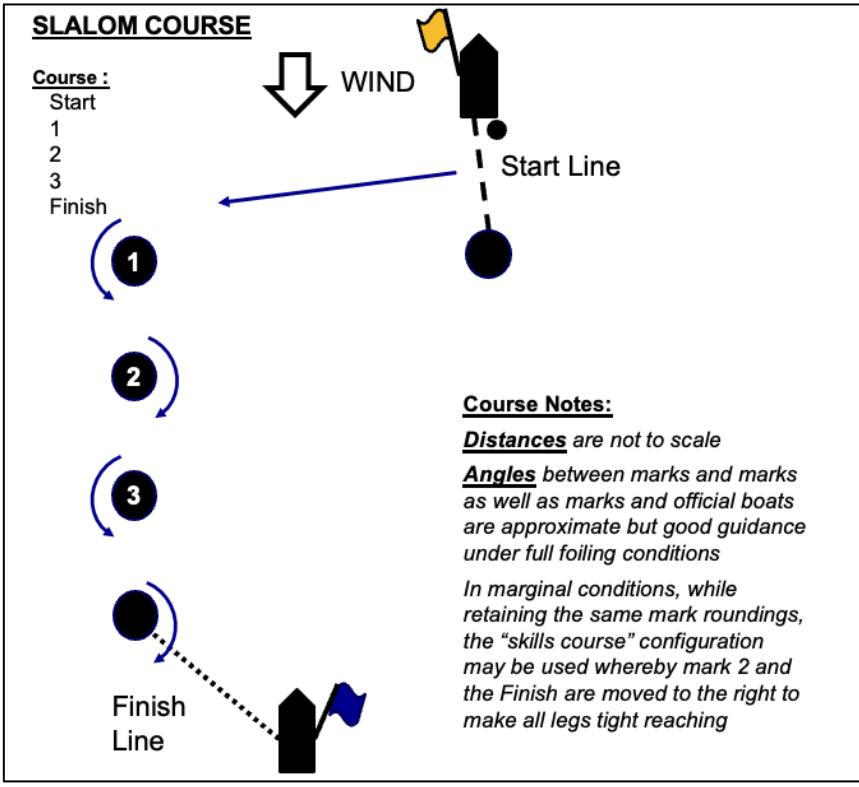
- 1.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole in the WSC boatyard.
- 1.2 Signing sheets will be available at the WSC reception counter.
- 1.3 Protest hearing request forms to be submitted via the WSC sailing office (first floor).

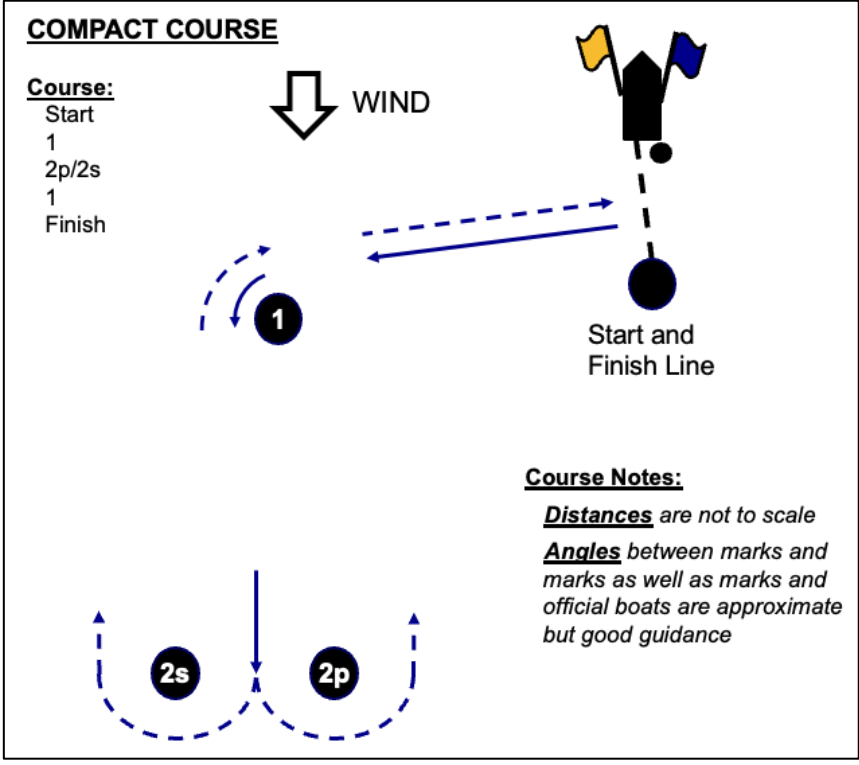
2. SCHEDULE OF RACES AND START SEQUENCE

- 2.1 A maximum of 14 races will be sailed for the championship.
- 2.2 The Start will use the 3 minute sequence as described in SRD 10.4

3. COURSES & MARKS

- 3.1 The possible courses are set out in the following diagrams.
- 3.2 All marks are inflatable cylindrical cones with colours set out next to the diagrams.
- 3.3 The course (i.e. Slalom or Compact)
 - a) To be initially used will be posted on the ONB prior to each day's competitor briefing.
 - b) May subsequently be changed on the water by the Race Committee flying Flag L and hailing competitors.
